Estate - The estate in Soave is just a few kilometers from Verona, on a slope overlooking the valley. The estate is uniquely situated 150 meters high, which is high for the region. The vineyards are 80-100 years old with a quarter of the vines on their original rootstock. The soils range from volcanic tuff to chalk to clay and limestone. The different soils contribute greatly to the wines acidity, minerality and ageability.
