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Nadia curto in La Morra shows a sure touch in producing a wine modelled on the Arborina of her uncle Elio Altare, vinified in roto-fermenters and aged in barriques. The oak is discreet on the nose, which features cherry and savoury aromas. Rich and forthright, it shows considerable opulence and generosity of ripe fruit in the mouht, and although the tannins are forceful now, they should soon integrate. A long energetic finish.
